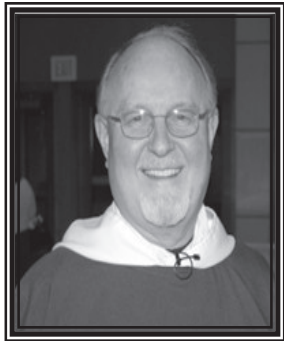

On this Palm Sunday of the Passion of the Lord we start Holy Week. Will we keep it holy? Let's hope so. Please take your calendar now and make sure you have reserved Holy Thursday at 7 PM so that you will be with us to be part of the Washing of the Feet and the sharing of the Last Supper. It is a holy time. Please be with us.

And again on Good Friday we have planned our liturgy for 7 PM so that you will be able to attend. Good Friday is a time when we need to be together as family to hear the story of our lord's passion and death. On Good Friday we always take the passion from John's gospel.

On Holy Saturday again the family needs to be together to light the new fire, bring the Easter Candle into the church, remember our ancestors and celebrate the great sacraments of baptism, confirmation and Holy Communion. Please plan to be with us. It happens once a year! We will have the two regularly scheduled masses on Easter Sunday.
