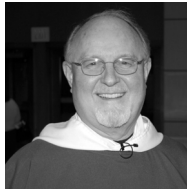

Dear Sisters and Brothers,



During the Easter Season we reflect on our Baptism, Confirmation and on the great gift of the Holy Eucharist. All three sacraments give us the grace to become intimately connected to Jesus Christ through the Holy Spirit. The closeness is sometimes felt more than at other times. But it is there whether we think about it or not. It is there no matter what we do, good or bad. But for the power of Christ in us to be released in good works, we must cooperate with God's grace and not play it off as something we take for granted.

For those who have just been baptized, we are offering them an opportunity to deepen their faith in a process called "mystagogy," or post-baptismal catechesis for the neophytes. The best way for our new members to grow in their faith is to be present for the weekend liturgy, to actively participate in bible study and other faith formation programs. We also intend to keep meeting with the neophytes and those who were received into full communion in the Catholic Church.

But what about us, those who were baptized long ago? We need the same "mystagogy" as our new members. We need to be refreshed and renewed in our faith. We might even consider taking a more active role in the life of the church. For this purpose we are beginning our "nomination/discernment" process for all members who may want to go deeper in their faith and take on specific ministries at

All Saints. If you are interested in the "nomination/discernment process, please let me know. We will be asking all members to nominate those they feel might be ready to serve their church in a new and more exciting way. The dates and times for the Discernment Process are:
