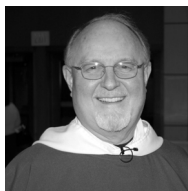

During the past week, twenty-four of our members participated in the annual nomination/discernment process for parish leaders. I am grateful to all who came out for this most important event in the life of the church. All participants will be better equipped to be leaders after these informative and prayerful sessions. Thanks to everyone who participated.

During the course of the next few months, we will be starting "Phase II" of our Unity in Christ Fund Raising Program. We will be inviting all members who have not yet pledged or donated to the building renovation to begin to do so. If you have not pledged and want to sign your pledge card now, please call Debbie Timko at the parish office. For all members who are giving so generously now, I thank you. Your gifts make it possible for us to pay our monthly note to Catholic Family Life.

Beginning in the fall, our Sunday school we will be adding our 7th through 12th graders to our program. For many years, the 7th through 12th graders having been part of a joint program with St. Martin DePorres Parish. The joint program will continue with a once a month large group meeting and it will be held at All Saints. We are now looking for catechists to help teach the Good News to our young people. We are also hopeful that this move will bring more of our young people to the program and to Sunday Mass. It's up to us to make the program exciting and relevant for our young people.

On May 24 we will be having our next Festival of Faith with an emphasis on the Sacrament of Holy Orders. We will have Fr.
