Dear Sisters and Brothers,

From Monday October 15 through Friday October 19, I will be on retreat at the Valley of Our Lady Monastery in Prairie du Sac, Wisconsin. This is a Cistercian Monastery of Nuns and their primary source of income is baking altar bread. We receive our bread from them. I have been asked to clarify a statement made in one of our communications about our outreach ministries. The article led some to believe that we were paying the tuition of someone attending Alverno College. We are not. What we are doing is making it possible for the women to attend college because she is living at the Commons with her five children, after living in her car. We applaud her for her decision to attend college and Alverno for making it possible for her to attend.

I have been receiving advice from a number of people concerning the day and time for the next Town Hall Meeting. Some think it should not be on the Lord's Day because it may get contentious, some say don't have it after masses because there is not enough time, others say have it on a week night. I am inclined to keep to our original plan and that is to have it after each mass on October 28th, our next Hospitality Sunday. I would hope that members with questions would submit them now so they can be answered either through the bulletin or at the meeting itself. We can have a meeting each month as a way of keeping people informed.

And as for it being contentious, I would hope and pray that whatever is said would be said in a loving and kind way. We are seeking to be faithful to the command of Christ: "I am giving you a new command. You must love each other, just as I have loved you. If you love each other, everyone will know that you are my disciples." (John 13: 34-35) And anything we do in this parish ought to be in keeping with that command of Christ.

I have just found out that one of the women we have been helping has died of an overdose: Jaimilla Smith. Some months ago I asked her to write down what she wanted for her funeral. I asked that to let her know how close to death she was. I am deeply saddened. She leaves two beautiful children and a mom who has been expecting the call she has now receive for a long time. May she rest in peace.

Financial Reports

David LaCroix chairs the Finance Committee at All Saints. Other members of the committee are Marvin Pratt, Earnest Daniels, Vida Matthews (trustee), and Michael Adams (trustee). The committee meets monthly. If you are interested in serving on the committee, please submit your name to Jackie Stone, the President of the Parish Council.

The Finance Committee is responsible for the annual budget, monitoring income and expenses, keeping the Parish Council informed of the financial situation, informing the membership through bulletin announcements and pulpit announcements. The recommended format for reporting to the parish is through the bulletin insert, the one page document that summarizes the detail. If people want more detail, the members of the committee would be glad to meet with you. Some people do want more detail and that is certainly their right, since they are the ones supporting the ministry and mission at All Saints Catholic Church.

The financial reserves that we received from the sale of the church properties back ten years ago were used for the renovation project. There are still monies in the account but there are still bills to be paid from our construction company. The remainder of the money needed to complete the project came to us as a loan from Catholic Family Life Assurance for \$900,000. That mortgage is being met by new money raised from our Unity In Christ Fund. To date, we have \$400,000 in pledges and cash receipts. Lee and Lynn Menefee head the committee charged with raising pledges. Other members include Gerald and Julie Adams, Marvin Crowe, Gwen Dansby, Marvin Pratt, Ruby Snowden, Albert Thompson, and Debra Timko.

The committee is gearing up for Phase Two of the Unity in Christ Fund pledge campaign. The goal is \$900,000. If you have not pledged, please call the office and someone from the committee will be in touch with you. And when you are called, please receive the call graciously knowing how difficult it might be for the solicitor!
