Dear Sisters and Brothers,

Jamillah Smith was a 36 years-old heroin addict. She lived at the Commons for a while until it became very obvious that she had no intentions of leaving her deep-seated addiction to harmful drugs. She was put out, but we did not stop loving her or trying to help her. Jamillah died last week of an over-dose. She leaves behind two beautiful children and a grieving mother. Her mother has now lost her second daughter to violence—one through murder by firearms and now, Jamillah, through addiction!

About a month ago I asked Jamillah to write down what she wanted me to do for her funeral. Reluctantly she wrote down a few things. She said she wanted the hymn Amazing Grace, the Lord's Prayer, The 23<sup>rd</sup> Psalm, additional prayers and to be dressed in a peach dress. I found the paper last Friday.

Jamillah was a slave to her addictions. She would do anything to get enough money to score some drugs. She sold her body, her simple possessions, she slept in abandoned buildings, between parked cars, and anywhere she could. And all the while planning how to get that next little bit of money to purchase the only thing that got her excited, drugs and the temporary high they produced.

We loved her and wanted so much that she come through these 16 years of addiction clean and able to take care of her precious children as God intended. She didn't make it, as so many don't.

I sit here wondering what we could have done. I know she is not the last of our be-

loved brothers and sisters to die from the very thing that made her so happy, euphoric. Prayer certainly is the first thing we can do. Certainly we must never lose faith of the possibility that a person can overcome and save their life. And we must also continue to love them in spite of the horrible things they are doing to themselves.

Jamillah is our sister. We loved her and we mourn her death. We are holding a memorial service for Jamillah on Sunday, October 21st at St. John de Nepomuc on the corner of 38th and Keefe at 4:30 p.m.
