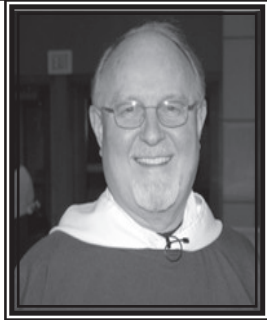

Dear Sisters and Brothers,

We are gearing up to conduct a Pledge Campaign for 2012. The goal of the campaign is to increase our regular income to the point where we can pay all our bills on time. That will mean that our average weekly income will need to be around \$10,000. Currently, we receive financial gifts totaling around \$5000-\$6000. So, you can easily see that with that kind of cash flow we are not able to pay the regular bills that come as part of being a vibrant faith community.

The goal of the campaign, as I said, is to raise our financial gifts received to a total of \$10,000 each week. For that to occur, we need you. We need you to give serious thought, prayer, and consideration to our request for an increase in giving. We are asking for increased giving in a manner that challenges heroic giving, while at the same time respects the fact that giving is a voluntary act. All things being equal, giving is based very much on our faith and on our understanding of our obligation to support the local parish that we are part of.

Together we must pray and work to remove whatever is blocking generous giving. As a start, we intend to present the membership with hard facts concerning our bills. As presented in our town hall meeting, the majority of our income goes to pay the mortgage, maintenance, utilities, salaries and such things as insurance. These expenses must be met in order to continue carrying out our ministries and mission. The budget we proposed for 2011-2012 is balanced. But to keep it in balance, we need additional revenue.

The membership at All Saints provides approximately 66% of the total amount needed to operate All Saints. The additional 34% comes from rental property and grants. I write to foundations, churches and individuals who are on our donor mailing list. Please know that your ideas to raise additional reve-

nue are important and I welcome them too.

As I said, generous giving is really a faith thing. We know that many of our members who have very little discretionary income give generously to All Saints. In fact, 65% of the membership gives financial support at this time. Our hope is that with prayerful consideration all of our members will increase their contributions.

To those of you who now support All Saints with such wonderful generosity, I thank you. You keep us going. I ask you, the most generous donors, to consider giving even more, if at all possible. No gift is too small or too large in the eyes of God our generous life-giver.
